COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS TO CRAFTS AND MUSIC

1. Only those individual performers under contract will be admitted free to musical programs.
2. Only those individual craftsmen under contract will be admitted free to craft areas.
3. Employees of the Center and Department of Parks & Tourism who are on duty may be admitted free access to both crafts areas and auditorium.
4. Guest musical performers who are scheduled to entertain on a specific date may be admitted on that date. Guest performers to be admitted free must be approved by the OFC Music Coordinator or the Master of Ceremonies prior to beginning of program.
5. The only passes to be honored are the official season tickets. Said ticket is valid for only those members of a family residing in same household.

The General Manager may, at his discretion, allow free admission to both crafts area and auditorium for promotional purposes, (i.e. legislators, press, travel writers, elected dignitaries, commissioners, etc.).
